JULY - INTERGENERATIONAL "HANDS-ON" MISSION PROJECTS

Next Sunday, July 12, is part one of a two part mission project that will be sending care packages to U.S. soldiers in Afghanistan. This part involves letter writing to make connections with the men and women soldiers. We will be providing outlines for letter writing, pictures, coloring supplies, and all materials to make it possible for all ages to make a connection with a soldier in Afghanistan. We will begin with a short introduction to the soldiers who will be the recipients of our care packages. During the month of July we are collecting items to go into care packages that will be sent at the end of the month (part 2 of the project).

Items being collected are:

- Hygiene: Baby Wipes, shampoo, body soap, Q-tips, toothpaste, shaving cream, razors, and hand sanitizer
- Food: Chips, pretzels, gum, candy bars, hard candy, popcorn (popped), drink mix (single serving)
- Entertainment: DVD's or XBOX games
