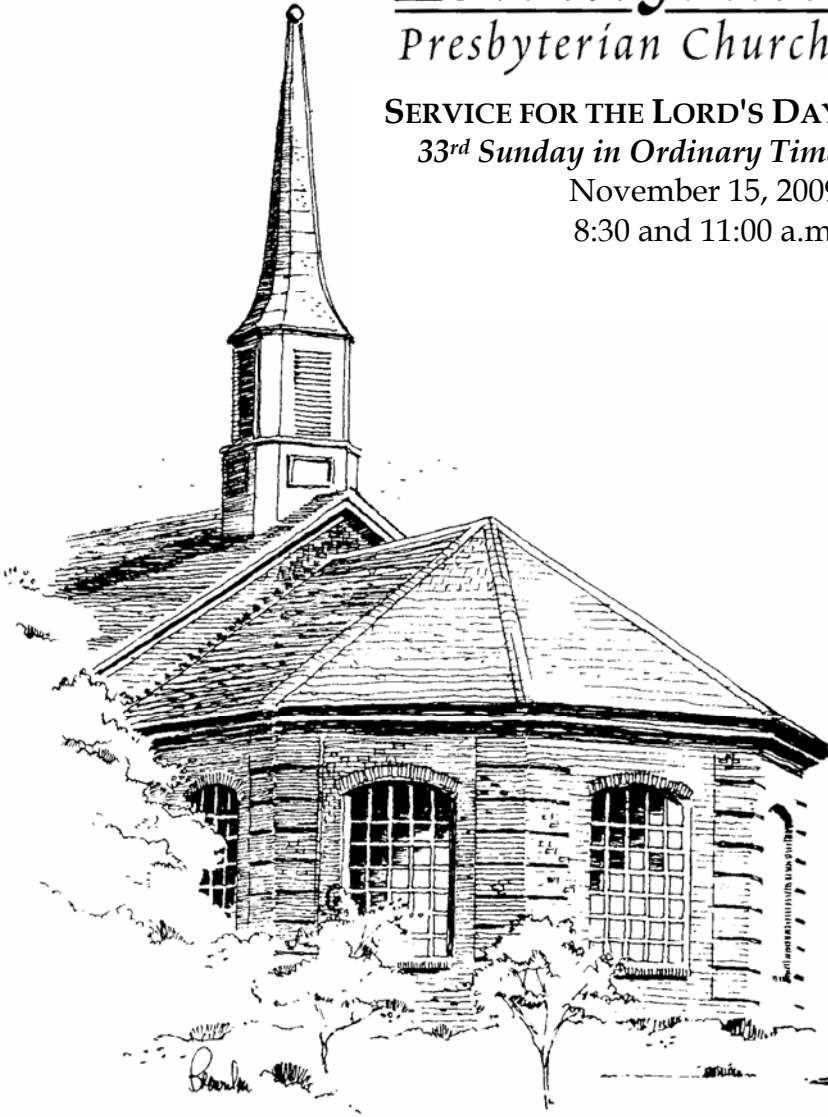


Lewinsville Presbyterian Church
