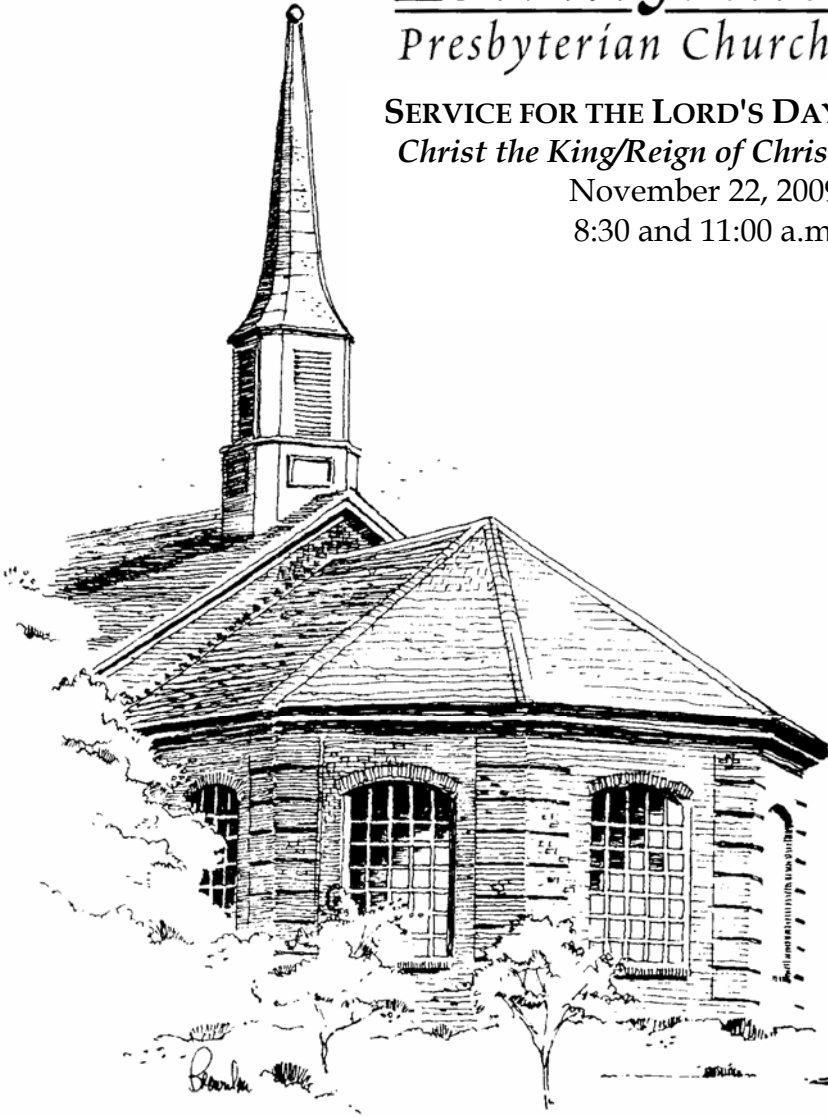


# Lewinsville Presbyterian Church
