

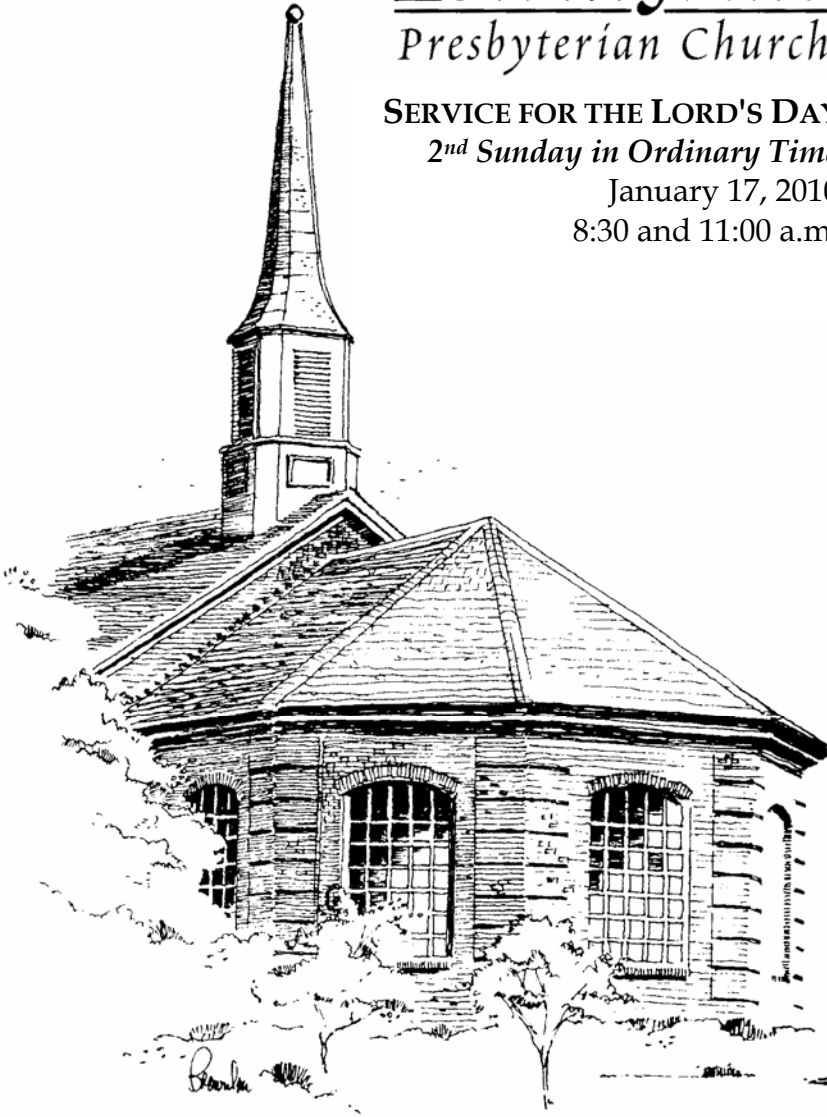

MISSION AND SERVICE NEEDS:

- **Winter in the City - Sweaters, jackets and coats, caps, and flannel shirts in good condition** are needed for Christ House patients and the homeless men who use the **Unity Health Care** (formerly **Health Care for the Homeless**) shower room at Christ House.

New men's **underwear** and **socks** are especially needed for shower program users who must have new underwear in order to visit the Christ House/UHC medical staff.

- **Unity Health Care** also distributes **blankets** from its van on cold nights to homeless men and women living on the streets of Washington. **Used blankets**, in reasonable condition (frayed or missing binding is OK) are greatly needed. Your warm **blanket** could make a life and death difference! If each LPC pledging unit provided one used **blanket** from its household, we would have approximately 350 **blankets**. **Please, no quilts, bedspreads or comforters.**

Just one pair of socks, a package of men's underwear, or an outgrown sweater will bring comfort and warmth to one of the poorest of Christ's children. Please be generous in your giving throughout the cold winter months.

Presbyterian Assistance to Haiti

This information is as of Wednesday, January 13, 6pm

While we were finishing up tasks at work, driving in traffic, preparing dinner, doing homework on Tuesday evening, a powerful earthquake shook the nation of Haiti. The tremor destroyed many buildings and cost many lives.

Lewinsville Church supports the Poor Children's Assistance Project near Port-Au-Prince, Haiti. We have learned (1) the orphanage at Coq Chante has at least partially collapsed; (2) at least one orphan has died, a little girl; and (3) the Juste family, who run the project, are all safe but their home has been destroyed to the point that they are afraid to reenter it.

Haiti, the poorest country in the Western hemisphere, is ill-equipped to handle such destruction. The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) is still contacting its many partners in the country, and has set a \$1,000,000 goal for assistance to Haiti. Funds from One Great Hour of Sharing are already helping with the initial response.

What is most needed is funds for medical supplies, food, water, and shelter. You can contribute to the disaster relief through Lewinsville Church. Please make your check payable to Lewinsville Presbyterian Church, with "DR000064" or "Haiti Disaster Relief" in the memo line.
