

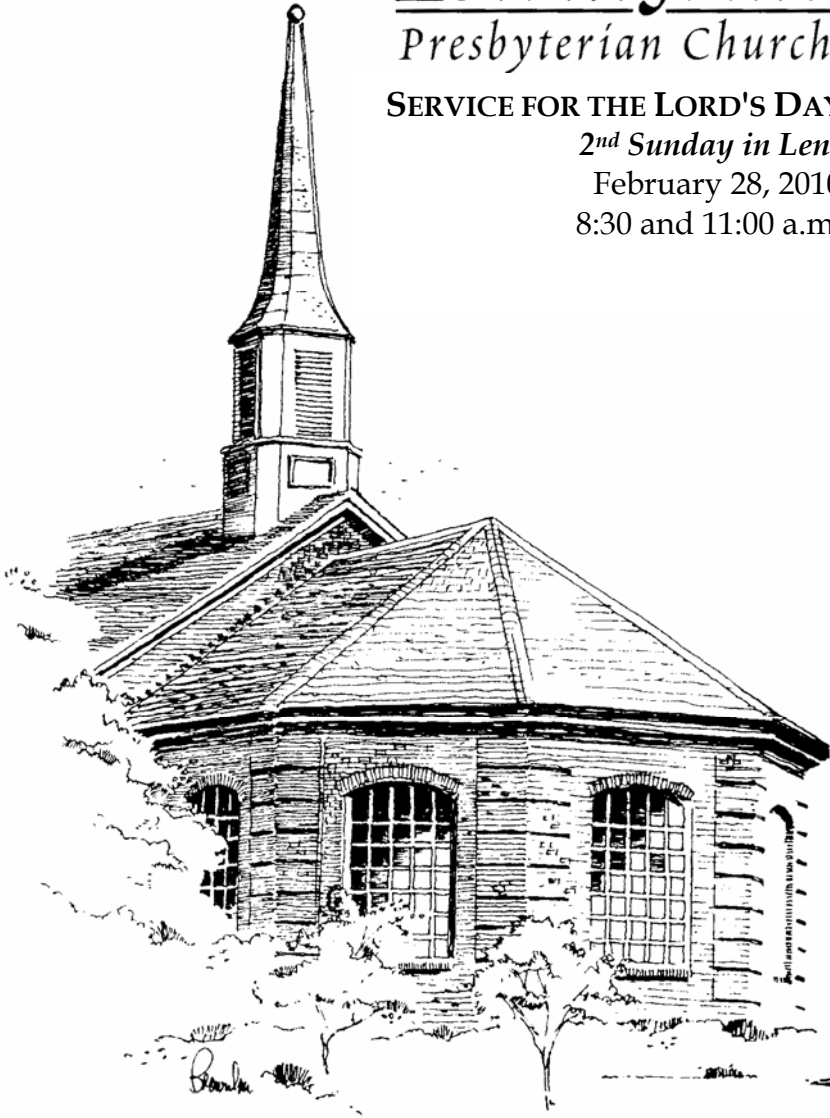

- ❖ Join the team that works on the *Peters Property* to provide a park-like area combining shade, grass and a flagstone patio area.
