

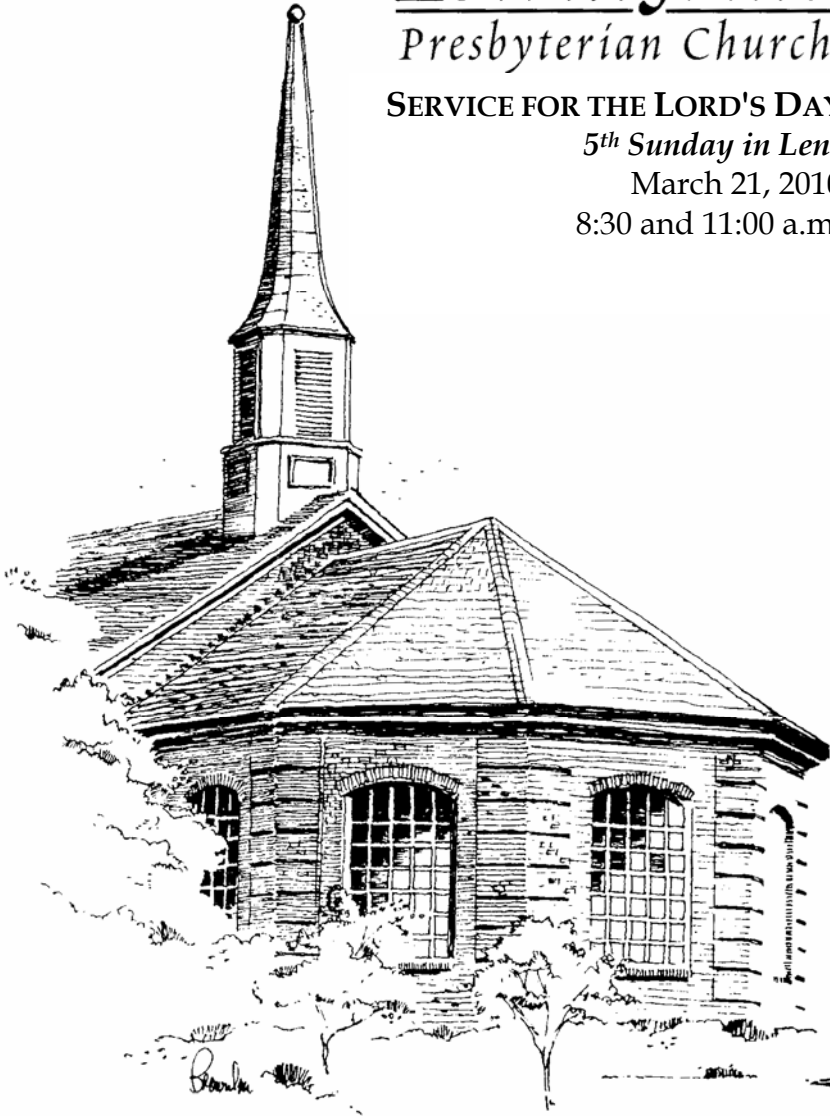

ANNUAL EASTER EGG HUNT EGG COLLECTION - Parents of the participants of the Easter Egg Hunt are asked to bring at least one dozen filled plastic eggs to church by 9:00 a.m. Easter Sunday. Eggs will be collected in boxes in the volunteer room.

ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING - For over fifty years Presbyterians have supported the One Great Hour of Sharing Offering. This offering goes toward three programs in the PC(USA) that help the neediest among us.

1. Presbyterian Hunger Program 36%: For ministries working to alleviate hunger and eliminate its causes, responding with compassion and justice to poor and hungry people in local communities, in the nation and throughout the world, as well as ministries addressing homelessness and affordable housing.
2. Presbyterian Disaster Assistance 32%: For disaster response and ministries with refugees.
3. Self-Development of People 32%: For partnerships with groups of people who are oppressed by poverty or social systems, who want to take charge of their own lives, have organized to do

something about their own condition, and have decided what they need to do to produce long-term benefits for themselves.

One Great Hour of Sharing money was sent to Church World Service to help toward disaster assistance relief in Haiti and Chile following the recent earthquakes. You will find envelopes in the pew racks during Lent. We will receive the offering **Sunday, April 4**. Please give generously on Easter.
