

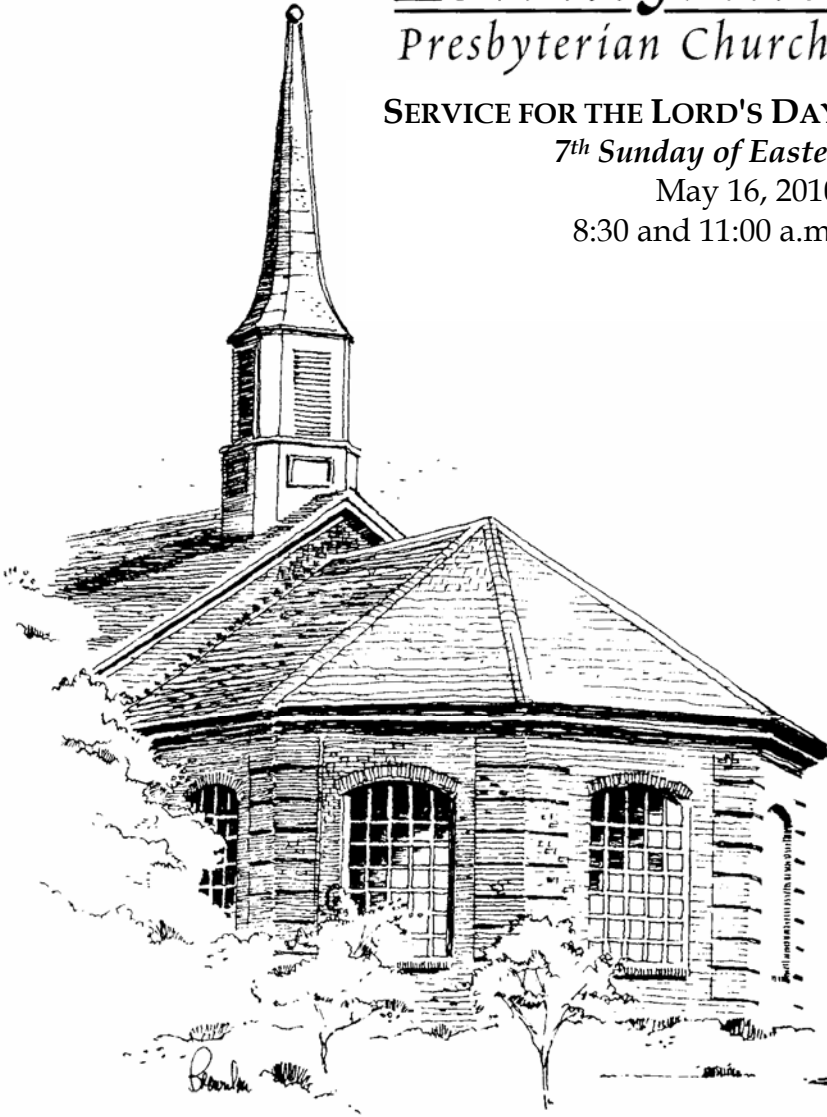

Speakers: **Bruce Douglass, PhD**, Professor Government, Georgetown University and

David Morrison, Corporate Vice President for Government Operations, Boeing, Inc.; formerly Democratic Staff Director of the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Defense

Topic: **Obama, Niebuhr, and the War in Afghanistan**

What are some of the factors that Christians should consider in assessing U.S. actions and perceptions of our security interests in the war in Afghanistan? Does it pass the test of classic just war theory? Or is it another expression of U.S. imperialism that Christians should oppose? What would prominent 20th century theologian Reinhold Niebuhr say? What would Jesus say?

Bruce Douglass will explore Niebuhr's thinking on the political and military actions of governments in relation to war so that we can apply it to the Afghanistan situation and the "war on terrorism." David Morrison, who was deeply involved in funding the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan in the House of Representatives, will bring his knowledge and understanding of relevant U.S. policy to help Christians evaluate an appropriate stance. David is Presbyterian and also had strong links with pacifist Quakers in his youth.
