

## Gress-Miles Pipe Organ

The organ at Lewinsville Presbyterian Church was built by the Gress-Miles Pipe Organ Company of Princeton, New Jersey and installed in 1985. Gress-Miles utilized nearly all the original pipework from the previous Casavant organ. The Bombarde 8' and Trumpet 4' in the Great Organ were added in 1997.
