SENIOR HIGH SUNDAY SCHOOL MENTOR**

JOB/TASK: *Senior High Sunday School Mentor*

NUMBER OF PERSONS NEEDED: *Team of 2-4*

TIME COMMITMENT/FREQUENCY: *9:45 - 10:45, 2-3 times/month, September-May*

Senior High Sunday School is led by the youth in the class. The leadership is rotated on a volunteer basis. Classes take place during the CE hour on Sunday mornings, from September through June. A variety of curriculum and materials are used, depending on the topic. Time for sharing joys and concerns is included, and class ends in prayer for one another.

The class mentor is an adult who attends class infrequently (2-3 times per month) to participate in (not lead) discussions and be aware of any special victories, concerns or challenges being faced by the youth and his or her family. The mentor should coordinate the teaching schedule with the youth to ensure each week is covered and assist the youth leaders with discussion topic ideas and resources.

The class mentor also maintains relationships with the students outside of Sunday school, i.e. Facebook or e-mail communication, attending student's events, etc.
