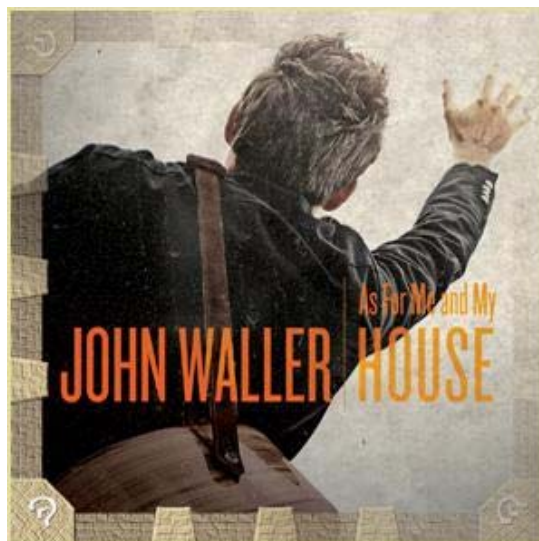
As for John and John's house
