All items are made by disadvantaged artisans who earn a fair wage in safe working conditions. In addition, the products are made from locally sourced, recycled, and renewable materials. Ten Thousand Villages promotes creative re-use and energy efficiency in artisan workshops and seeks to minimize their environmental footprint.

In keeping with our being an Earth Care Congregation, this year we are adding another table where a few environmentally safe, recycled, and energy-saving household products will be available for purchase or ordering.
