A Note about the Prelude in today's worship service: The Prelude was performed on Lewinsville's historic reed organ. During recent maintenance work on the organ, we discovered and restored a new rank (the 4' reed), restored expressive wind bellows (allowing more dynamic contrast), thoroughly tuned the instrument, deep cleaned the ivory keyboard, fixed a stuck mechanism in the bass register of the keyboard, and repaired the music stand.
