Ned Rorem (1923-) studied composition at Northwestern University, Curtis Institute of Music, and Julliard School of Music. Time Magazine has called him the "World's Best Composer of Art Song." His suite *Air Music* won the 1976 Pulitzer Prize in music. The Atlanta Symphony recording of his *String Symphony, Sunday Morning*, and *Eagles* received a Grammy Award in 1989. The Ned Rorem Archives are at the Library of Congress, Music Division, Washington DC.

Evan Ayars (1983-) serves as Children's Music Specialist and Tenor Section Leader in the Chancel Choir at Lewinsville Presbyterian Church. Evan is Choral Director at Chantilly High School. Evan received his BA in Music from James Madison University and his Master's degree in Music Education at George Mason University.
