

WUFOO FORMS HELP

CSS that can be used in Wufoo Forms:

Sometimes you may want to shorten a form by putting two fields side by side. An example of doing this is here: <https://lewinsville.wufoo.com/forms/thanksgiving-dinner-2019-donate-food/> This is a very complex form that was used at Thanksgiving 2019 for our Thanksgiving meal program. (And since Covid, we have not done this again). This form has limits set up and some of the fields are grayed out because the limit had been reached. But look at the appetizers and bread. If one is checked, a new field pops up on the right. This is not only handled for a form rule, but also by CSS code. The Appetizer field and the bread field have the code `rightHalf` in the CSS field set up, and the "How many ..." field for each has `leftHalf` in the CSS field set up. I've put the actual code to use in red type.
