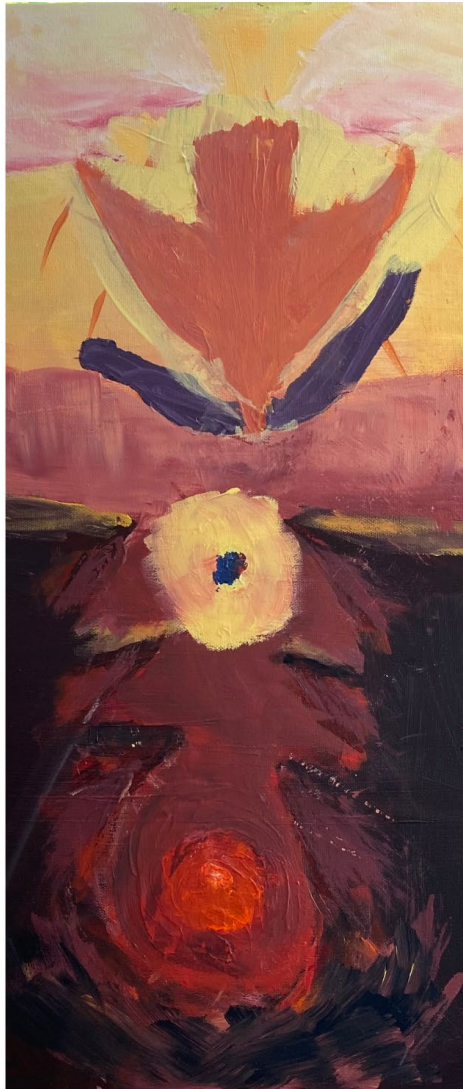

From the 175th Anniversary Notebook - With \$2,000 borrowed from the cemetery fund, the church bought its first computer in 1984—an IBM 8088, complete with monitor, keyboard, and printer. And was it powerful! Two bays in the front accommodated two 5.25" floppy disks. When both sides of one disk were used, it could store 320 kb of data. In the 1984 annual report, the church administrator wrote, "Our computer is already full of data entered by volunteers." Initial resistance from staff soon melted away as the computer's contribution to office efficiency and productivity became obvious. Of course, in 1984, no one could imagine the speed with which technology would change all of our lives. Surely, our recently completed renovation with its new technology has prepared us for unrevealed new ministries.

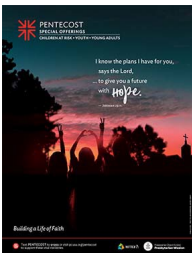

The remaining sixty percent is distributed at the national and international levels toward child advocacy (10%), youth ministry (25%), and Young Adult Volunteer (YAV) opportunities (25%). The forty percent that will stay in our local area we have designated to go toward the Young Adult Volunteer Program that is supported by National Capital Presbytery. The Young Adult Volunteer Program is a dear program to Pastor Layne who served as the New Orleans YAV Site Coordinator for 7 years. Please give generously as you are able.
