

*From the 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Notebook* - Anniversary celebrations have always been great opportunities to showcase the enormous talents of Lewinsville members. For the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 1996, Duane and Betty McKenna designed a tapestry to reflect the history and ministries of our church. The completed tapestry, now hanging in the chapel, took nine months to create and required more than 900,000 needlepoint stitches. The *McLean Connection* of October 9, 1996 noted the milestone celebration with a front page photo of the women who labored more than 5,000 hours to create the tapestry: Karen Steel, Betty McKenna, Anne Clare, Bettie McElroy, Nancy McGuire, Caroline Van Wagoner and Carol Kaffenberger. Betty McKenna praised the quality of the work, and said, "The tapestry should last another 150 years."
