

To celebrate Hispanic Heritage Month, Lewinsville's music ministry will be performing composers of LatinX and Spanish cultures

Manuel Ponce (1882-1948) was a Mexican composer, music educator and scholar of that connected Western Classical tradition with popular song and Mexican folklore. He was the earliest internationally successful Mexican composer of classical music. He wrote extensively for piano, chamber ensemble, and orchestra, and is best known for works for guitar and collaboration with Andrés Segovia, folk-song arrangements, and many original songs. Most famous of the latter is "Estrellita" (1912), for which Ponce also wrote the text.

Fiesta composed by Emma Lou Diemer (1927-) was written for one of the concerts at Trinity Episcopal in Santa Barbara, CA that took place each year during the "Old Spanish Days" Fiesta. It suggests guitar strumming in the middle section and incorporates Latin American syncopated rhythms.
