





ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 16, 2022

The flowers in the sanctuary this morning are given to the glory of God by the McKeown family in loving memory of Mike McKeown, who died on September 27. A memorial service was held October 15 at Lewinsville.

LEWINSVILLE IN THE CIVIL WAR CEMETERY TOUR - As part of our celebration of Lewinsville's 175th anniversary, a self-guided tour (rescheduled from Kickoff Sunday, when it rained) will be available in the Lewinsville cemetery after the 11:00 service on Anniversary Sunday (10/16). Maps and signage will give participants a chance to explore the experiences of three groups who gathered in the Lewinsville sanctuary in its early days: European Americans born in Virginia, mostly on the Northern Neck, who moved to Fairfax County in the early 19th century, some fleeing British incursions during the war of 1812; the African Americans the first group enslaved; and relatively recent European American arrivals to Fairfax County from New York.

The tour traces how Lewinsville members handled escalating conflicts over slavery and secession, including differing views within the congregation and even within individual families; what they did during the Civil War; and how they began to regather afterward (at Lewinsville, and, in the case of African American participants, in Black-led congregations founded soon after the war, including Shiloh Baptist, with which Lewinsville has a growing present-day connection).

Cathy Saunders, who created the tour, will be available in the cemetery to answer questions and engage in dialogue about the significance of this era in Lewinsville's history and possible lessons for our present moment.
