Lighting of the Advent Wreath

Isaiah 9:2,6

Reader: A reading from the prophet Isaiah: The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who lived in a land of deep darkness – on them light has shined. For a child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

We first remember the prophets of old, who dared to speak of a child to come, who promised the coming of a Savior. The candle of prophecy

reminds us of the faithfulness of God's promises, so that we can live in hope.

People: We also give thanks for the prophets among us today, who bring us surprising visions of hope, who challenge us to think in new ways, and who show us a future that we would not otherwise have anticipated.

Reader: On this first Sunday of Advent, we light this candle as a symbol of the prophets who renew our faith and remind us of what may be.
