"A Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."

Luke 2:11-12

## The shepherds would have understood better than

 anyone the significance of the angel's words.Paschal Lambs were lambs meant for sacrifice during Passover. When they were born, shepherds wrapped them in cloths, placed them in a manger, and later checked them to make sure they were without blemish.

Placing Jesus in a manger pointed forward to how Jesus would be the sinless, blameless, and unblemished Lamb who was sacrificed for our sin.



God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
