During the coming year, our hope is that each person who participates in the ministries of this congregation will become more like Jesus, and that we as a community of faith become more like Jesus together. Along this path, we will be transformed from the inside out, we will become agents of joy in our hurting world, and we will discover that each one of us belongs to God, now and forever.
